5 Highlighters

4 Single subject notebooks about 10 ½" by 8" wide ruled

1 Assignment Notebook

Book covers (no covers that stick for hard covered textbooks)

4 boxes of tissues (**large size—200 count**)

1 rolls of paper towels

ART SUPPLES (to be kept in classroom)

Shoe box for art supplies (all art supplies must fit this box)

1 Box of 16 count crayons

1 Pair of scissors

1 Bottle of white glue (not glue sticks)

Water-based colored markers (NO SCENTED ONES)

Colored pencils (12 colors)

Homework Kit

Trapper Keepers and similar binders

White Out or related products

Novelty pens, pencils (including mechanical pencils), erasers,
and etc.

Calculators

Permanent markers
