

Middle School Supply List 2017-2018

Dear Parents of Incoming Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Grade Students,

Here is a list of items that the students will need for the upcoming school year. **They do not need any gadgets;** these tend to get in the way of learning and act as a distraction. They need only basic supplies for their everyday work. This sheet contains a list of supplies needed for school, and those needed for homework, as well as some of the items **not allowed** in school. All supplies are available at Staples, CVS, Wal-Mart, or Michael's.

Supplies needed in school

The following items are needed in the classroom and should be brought to school on the first day and **replenished as needed**.

- 1 scientific calculator – grades 7 and 8
- 8 GB USB/Flash drive
- 1 IC school bag
- 1 pkg. index cards
- 1 pair of safety scissors
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 pkg. black or blue erasable pens
- 4 different colored highlighters
- 10 Expo dry erase markers (blue, black, or brown only)
- 1 pkg. **sharpened #2 pencils**
- Simple serviceable rosary beads
- 2 large erasers “magic rub,” white vinyl or “pink Pearl”
- 4 book covers
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 container of antibacterial wipes
- 2 boxes tissues
- 1 twelve count box colored pencils
- 1 2 ½” binder and a three hole punch in the binder (for ELA, will be kept in school)
- 1 2 ½ “ binder (for remaining subjects)
- 2 packages of 5 dividers (10 total)
- 2 black and white composition notebooks
- 2 packages of 3-hole lined paper (to be used throughout the year)
- 10 (Avery binder pockets)
- 1 protractor and 1 compass
- 1 pkg. graph paper

The following supplies will be needed for homework. **Please keep these items at home.**

colored pencils and markers
dictionary and thesaurus
pens and pencils
stapler
4 extra marble composition books

White-out or related products
make-up
watches with alarms
hairspray, perfume, etc.
gum, candy, sugared drinks (including sodas and other carbonated beverages)
stuffed animals and toys
stuffed animal pencil cases
Sharpies and other permanent markers
novelty pens, pencils, erasers, etc.
